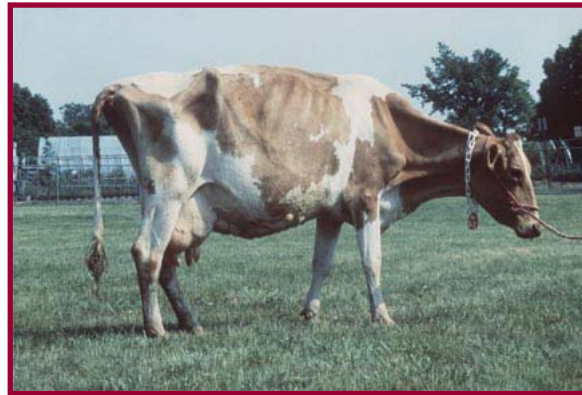

OVERVIEW

The Veterinary Extension Unit at The Ohio State University is hosting an In-Service for Extension Educators, Veterinarians, Registered Veterinary Technicians, and Public Health Officials.
