Keeping Up With Current Literature (Current Awareness Services)

Type of Search	Receive alerts when new articles of interest are available. Usually requires a free account or registration. Results may be delivered by email or RSS feed.

Create a preferred search within the catalog. The systems notifies you when new resources are added matching your search criteria.
Cited articles – <i>You are alerted when new articles citing a prior article are added</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ISI Web of Science: http://isiknowledge.com/ (My Citation Alerts)
Subject -- <i>Choose alert from predefined subject categories</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Faculty of 1000 Biology: http://f1000biology.com/ An online service in which almost 5,000 leading researchers and clinicians share their expert opinions by highlighting and evaluating the most important articles in biology.

Managing Citations

	Software that help store, manage, and format bibliographic citations.
RefWorks	<p>RefWorks: A web-based bibliography and database manager that allows users to create their own personal database by importing references from text files or online databases. You can use these references in writing your papers and automatically format the paper and the bibliography. Web of Knowledge: Science Citation Index 1965-	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A "cited reference" search by author will generate a list of suggested matches. Select appropriate articles and finish search. The number of times cited for each article is noted. 2. Or search for an individual article and view link to "times cited". 3. For a body of work by an author, search by author name and select "Create Citation Report" http://isiknowledge.com/
Journal Impact	
Web of Knowledge: Journal Citation Reports 1998-previous year	Locate metrics for individual journal title or grouped by subject. Impact factor measures journal's impact by comparing the number of times journal's articles are cited by other sources. http://isiknowledge.com/JCR

Article Express/Interlibrary Services (ILLiad)

	<p>Article Express provides electronic delivery of journal articles, book chapters, and proceedings papers to OSU faculty, staff, and students. The online Article Express form can be used to request articles from both OSU and non-OSU collections at no cost to you.</p> <p>Requests from the OSU Collections are usually filled within 3 business days; however, copies obtained from non-OSU collections may take longer. Users will receive an email message with a URL to ILLiad where they can log into their account and view or print the article. Users can access their articles on our server from any computer with internet access, a browser, and Adobe Acrobat reader.</p>
